

Bender Sets Collegiate, Junior Women's Indoor Compound National Records

MADISONVILLE, Ky. - Union College archer Raegan Bender was literally on target Friday as she set a pair of national records in indoor women's compound at the Mid-South Conference (MSC) Indoor Championships.

The freshman from Omaha, Neb., recorded a score of 592 out of a possible 600 in the event to best the national marks in the collegiate and junior categories. The previous record for both was 590 out of 600.

Bender hit 52 10-point targets and eight 9-point targets in amassing the 592 score.

Teammates Haley Golden and Jamilee Moore also had strong showings in the event as they finished second and third with scores of 586 and 582, respectively.

The MSC Indoor Championships concludes on Sunday. A full recap of Union's exploits will be released following the event's conclusion.
